Old, nearly lost French variety, origin unknown, formerly grown in the French region "Champagne-Ardenne" close to the burgundy region. Found in the backyard of an old former hop grower, by my parents while on a wine-and-cheese-tasting excursion in France.

Best for:

Top-fermented beers especially Wheat beers, Session Ales, light Pale Ales, Saison and belgian type Pale Ales

Bottom-fermented beers: late hop addition in Pils and Festbier

Hop addition:

wort kettle, whirlpool, cellar (dry-hopping)
